Tale of 2 Offensive Machines

At least one ghost of the past would be proud.

Edgerrin James' 219-yard, 3-touchdown afternoon last Sunday against Seattle helped the Anchorage Kitchen to a big victory over powerful Narcoossee. Kitchen Coach Nate Sagan got pretty brave afterward, boasting of his team's conquest of "God boy and his drill sergeant-haircut-havin' wife."

Anchorage's victory brought to light the notion that winning the Horshack Division may not be as easy a coaching task as handing Kurt Warner (aforesaid God boy) the football. But Narcoossee's Wit Tuttell cared so much, he left for Great Britain and couldn't be reached.

He did, though, have the balls to submit a transaction request for Pete Stoyanovich, who had just been signed by the Rams.
